This was both a remarkably successful NATS and a remarkable effort by Debbie Scattergood (Cullbookie) who turned out a very large team of excellent animals which competed against quality line-ups in every class.

Our international judge, Charles Steidensticker (Texas) was every bit as skilful and erudite as expected. His skill was especially seen in the Youth NATS which for the first time took up most of the Friday's events. Here the long experience (in the Texan scene and with keen 4H club involvement) was demonstrated. Charles was ably assisted by Eleanor Santolin (runner up in last August's National Youth Judging Championship).

This year three big teams of wethers were exhibited from 3 schools. And, the Youth Judging competition ably hosted by Lynn Carter, featured a huge entry, keeping both Mandy Statham and Philip Oliver busy with the scorekeeping.

It was observed that the older classes showed some variation in general type. When queried it was reported that judging aimed to pick out the best animals. Obviously, there is more than one style of Angora, but ribbons should go to the best and not necessarily all following one particular fashion.

Finally, a huge thanks must go to Nick Gorrie, not only for the organisation of the 2019 NATS but for his endurance over the years to make this even an on-going success.
