All animal entries must be accompanied by an NVD

NATS Youth Show

1. All animals entered must be owned by the school and be current financial members of Mohair Australia Ltd as Educational Members or if a registered stud, Breeder Members.
2. School Classes A&B will be assessed against the rules outlined in the MAL Paraders Guidelines.
3. **Class A** - Schools' Team of 3 Led Wethers. Judged as a group, with emphasis on the animal/fleece and uniformity of the team.
4. **Class B** - Schools' Individual Led Wether Paraders. Students judged on their ability to control and present the animal. Halters used.
5. **Class C** - Youth Paraders. Any animal entered in the show by any exhibitor. Student to have some knowledge of the animal. Animal to be used only once. No halters.
6. **Class D** - Young Judges. Student will judge 4 animals and 4 fleeces. 10 minutes allocated to each section. Scored using the Hormel Scale.
7. **Class E** - Doe under 1 year bred by the school
8. **Class F** - Buck under 1 year bred by the school
9. School Class E&F must carry an eID for animals born from 1 January 2025. Refer MAL Bi law 12.

NATS Fleece Show

1. Fleeces entered in all classes and not composite fleeces must be owned by the exhibitor, who must be a current financial member of Mohair Australia Ltd.
2. Fleeces entered must not exceed 17cm in length.
3. Fleeces are to be delivered directly to the show pavilion prior to 11.00am on the day of the mohair fleece show.
4. Additional fleeces to those listed on a competitors entry form may be entered after the closing date and paid for on the day of the mohair fleece show.
5. The Keith McKenzie Trophy class entry must be 3 kg of Fine Kid or Kid or Strong Kid or Young Goat fleece.
6. Class of fleeces entered in the Keith McKenzie Trophy class must be identified on entry form and on the fleece at drop off.

Helmsman Sale

1. Animals entered for sale must be the bonafide property of the entrant.
2. The entrant must be a financial member of Mohair Australia Ltd.
3. Sale animals are to be presented for inspection prior to bidding starting.
4. Bids are to be registered with the Administration Team and will remain anonymous until the completion of the sale.
5. Bids are to be of a \$25 minimum increment
6. Payment for winning bids to be made directly with the seller.
7. Duration of the sale is at the discretion of the organisers.

NATS Stud Show

1. All animals entered must be owned by the exhibitor, who must be a current financial member of Mohair Australia Ltd.
2. All animals entered must be registered with Mohair Australia Ltd at least 3 weeks prior to the first day of the show.
3. Exhibits need not have been bred by the exhibitor, with the exception of entries in the Kamrock Breeders Class. No animal will be admitted to the show unless duly entered. No substitutes are permitted.
4. All animal ages are to be calculated as at the first day of the show
5. All animals entered and exhibited must have been clean shorn to a maximum length of 1cm on or after 1 August of the year preceding the show. Animals entered in the under 12-month classes are exempt.
6. All animals entered and exhibited must be crutched and wigged so the hair is clear of eyes and heavy stain from the breech is removed from does.
7. Junior class exhibits may be nominated upon payment of an additional fee per animal. Full details of each nominated animal must be provided to the Show Secretary no later than 1 week prior to the first day of the show.
8. Goats born from 1 January 2025 must be tagged with an NLIS eID tag before leaving a property. Refer MAL Bi law 12.
9. Schools in classes E & F may enter the relevant NATS Stud Class at no extra cost
10. Any exhibit which is in obvious ill health or affected by external parasites must be removed from the showgrounds along with all animals that travelled in the same vehicle.
11. The exhibitor shall be solely responsible for the spread of an infectious disease by or through an exhibit.
12. Animals shall be placed in the pens allocated to the exhibitor and only moved as authorised by the stewards.
13. Exhibitors shall provide their own forage and water containers.
14. The organisers will provide bedding straw
15. Stud displays and signage must not be set up in pens until the completion of the NATS Stud Show judging.
16. All fleece exhibits, Class winners, Champions and Reserve Champions must remain in the pavilion until the conclusion of the show.
17. The organisers have the right, without giving reason, to cancel any event or class, alter the conditions of any class, or alter the time of any event. Notice will be given to all exhibitors if this occurs.
18. The decision of the judge will be final.
19. Any dispute as to the interpretation of these conditions will be referred to the Chief Steward whose decision shall be final, except where breaches of the conditions of entry/show rules are established after the show when Clause 22 will apply.
20. Disputes unable to be resolved by the Chief Steward shall be referred to the Mohair Australia NSW Division Executive for ruling.
21. Mohair Australia NSW Division reserves the right to disqualify exhibitors and/or withdraw awards retrospectively where breaches of the rules are discovered after the show.
22. Perpetual trophies remain the property of Mohair Australia NSW Division and must be returned each year in good order
23. Mohair Australia Ltd shall not be responsible for any accident or damage caused to or by an exhibit and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the organisers harmless and indemnify it against any action arising from such damage.
24. The organisers accept no responsibility for the loss or damage of any exhibits or exhibitor property.
