## ***Lynndon Grove Background:***

Beginning with a selection of Texan- Australian base of animals with a minuet infusion of African genetics in the 1990's to our now Lynndon Grove herd of which is now 95% African infused genetics of Martysford and Careysbrook. In 1996- 10 does 10 kids and 10 yearlings was the starting point as part of our journey toward today's production of weaving type mohair with the A-Z Fibre Group. In partnership with Andrew Gossip we have developed a Kemp free, lustrous, soft handling fibre for the international market. With GT Ferrier approaching us to become a part of the interim project trial group in 2013 along with his yearly assessment of our herd to our situation now all does and bucks lines are retained as quality assessed breeding animals.

We are producing approximately 200 + kilos of first shearing kid averaging 21 mic 5.2 sd 24.3 cv with 98% under 25 micron range our average weight per animal is 1.3 kilos heavily skirted fleeces being presented for final quality assurance classing for the international market.

### *Our Breeding Philosophy:*

Our aim is to breed animals that are adaptable to other environments that are suitable for angora goats.

We breed for body type that has a dual purpose capacity of Mohair production and Meat qualities Mohair production- breeding does must have the ability to produce healthy kids and rare them well with little assistance and carry a well structured fleece throughout their production time on farm.

Purity, super lustre and elite mohair are our purpose for our breeding values.

Our mohair is Kemp free and has proven alignment of fibre of lock structure ideal for top making.

Our focus is producing four shearings of elite fibre from kids to intermediate does for the niche market overseas.

Our management systems is paramount for our production of fibre quality and our meat process of good live weights for meat buyers

Our selection process at joining time is putting the "Best with the Best "and "get the body type right the rest will look after its self".

Bucks are selected for their early maturing capacity, head type –masculinity, sound leg structure, meat traits and mohair fibre traits.

Lynne's selection process is predominately visual "hands on" at selection time.

After each shearing, selection criteria continues for all age groups of animals, they must show visually, a superior mohair quality and body type to continue in our breeding program of our herd with increasing emphasis being placed on quantitative data collection over time.

As from 2024 we have made the decision to retire from the industry All stock is FOR SALE from January 2024

Bucks are also available to suit growers' needs to improve their mohair production and profitability.

Feel free to discuss with Lynne & Don our management plans, also our breeding philosophy.

Lynndon Grove Angoras and Amarula Angoras are RMS accredited with A-Z Fibre Group.

***Bloodlines:*** Our doe lines based on Fern Hill Stud (imp Texans), Denbro, Texan and African genetics with a mixture of Arcadius Enchanter sire line of does of which are still prominent in our does breeding in pedigrees, adding diversity with some out cross lines pre 2012 giving us a sound line of doe genetics to work with.

In 2012 a major ET program was carried out with Cedar Grange African genetics to secure the last imported Martysford and Careysbrook bloodlines from Africa in transit to Texas to Dr Fred Speck and partners as live animal export. 10 does, 13 bucks were born in August of 2012 thus AMARULA STUD was established as a partnership with Andrew Gossip

We embarked on a major breeding program to move us forward in all aspect of our two studs, with our focus on mohair quality and body types to accomplish what we are presenting to the industry at the Sale.

Meneer is an imported embryo from Snyberg and Careysbrook breeding, which has become the Oupa (grandfather) of the herd. Through his sons and daughters you would be hard pressed to find a goat in our herd which doesn't have Meneer in its background today – a sire which has left a long legacy of excellence with his progeny. His sons Lereko twins Ingwe and Nyhala who were used heavily in Lynndon Grove have all produced their own type of progeny for us.



**CEDAR GRANGE BUFFEL** at Fred Specks property 2019

Buffel is an imported embryo from Martysford breeding. Fred Speck labelled him the best buck he ever imported to Texas. Buffel has left a huge mark in Texas as a producer of Top Stock, and has left his mark on our herd as well. The Buffel bloodlines still produces our top animals here in our herds.

**CEDAR GRANGE SCHALKS BURGER** –Exported to Dr Fred Speck 2010- No photo

Burger was an imported embryo from the Careysbrook stud in South Africa. He was the top of the 2009 embryo drop, but unfortunately died in a dog attack upon being released from quarantine in the US. He produced a number of top bucks, including Cedar Grange Cracker Jack, Lynndon Grove Viceroy and Dulark Kirby. The Careysbrook line animals are big bodied commercial type Africans, with long even fleeces. In recent years we have found that bringing back this line has improved commercial traits and bodies on our animals.

## SONS of BURGER



### **CEDAR GRANGE CRACKER JACK 10-051- Schalk Burger 24-sons - LYNNDON GROVE VICE-ROY L37 2546**

Cracker is a 2010 drop buck from our top 2009 Careysbrook line side, Schalk Burger. Cracker produced an even line of top producing doe's which are prominent in our herd today. Cracker, in his day, was a large buck carrying a stylish even ring lock fleece. Cracker has been a grand sire of many of our top buck producing does in the Lynndon Grove and Amarula herds

### **CEDAR GRANGE INYATHI**

Inyathi was a massive stud buck, which threw presence and type of a true South African stud sire. This top son of Buffel left a legacy of elite stud animals in our herd. Inyathi is the sire of our current top stud buck, Lynndon Grove Valentino.

### **CEDAR GRANGE LEREKO**

Our top Meneer son produced a great line of both bucks and doe's. He produced animals with dominant fleece traits, with evenness, lustre, along with softness, with a fine definition of staples all over the body of his progeny.

Sons of Lereko are Lynndon Grove Usher, half brothers Sergio and Santiago, have left a mark of improvement in the herds in Qld and NSW



**LYNNDON GROVE TRUMAN L37 2181** Truman's fibre alignment of his even fleece was truly elite. He was first of our WOW bucks! Bred from the Meneer line out of a Cracker Jack doe. Truman's fleece was of amazing quality for alignment of fibre, evenness, lustre and length. He had a low fibre micron and standard deviation, on every fleece test which he passed on to his progeny. His daughters are some of our producers of keeper bucks in Lynndon Grove herd



**AMARULA MANDEBAA A028**

Sired by Cedar Grange JoJo from the Mallee Park Joe and Top Bok line (Imported SA lines) he was a typical large body buck with an African long lock structure. In his only one season of breeding before his misadventure, he gave us some sound based breeding stock especially his son Lynndon Grove Ulysses who replaced him in the stud.



**LYNNDON GROVE UYLSSES L37 2467**

Ulysses was a large body buck, with extra length to his fleece. A special buck, which was used heavily in our herds as he was an outcross from our main imported lines, he improved body type and fleece length. He was a Mandebaa son out of a TRE 9005 daughter from the great Opium-Stordahlen doe 808, who was unbeaten in southern shows in the early 2010's.



**LYNNDON GROVE VALENTINO L37 2593**

This buck is truly one of a kind his elite progeny that we have produced in the Lynndon Grove and Amarula herd's have been extraordinary. He's a Cedar Grange Inyathi son ,a Buffel line that has been produced from the Cheetah doe line within our breeding program in using the imported genetics. I believe he is a specialty buck that has produced himself with several of his sons or daughters have proven themselves to be elite breeders and carry forward qualities of low micron fleeces and body type with large frames



**AMARULA RIO BRAVO A071**

We were lucky enough in 2017 to use Rivers 1107, bred by Helena Ypma in an AI program. Rivers 1107 has the best of the Texan genetics in Australia; with the famous Speck buck 404 prominent in his breeding. Rio Bravo combines the fleece of his sire, and the body of his dam, a full sister to Schalk Burger. We are very happy with the way he has bred in our herd, blending the best of the Texan & African lines and lowering the micron in his progeny.

We have continued in using son's of Amarula A071 in our herd of which are progeny from his grand son Lynndon Grove Xanado we are offering grand daughters and grandson's for sale at this sale and privately

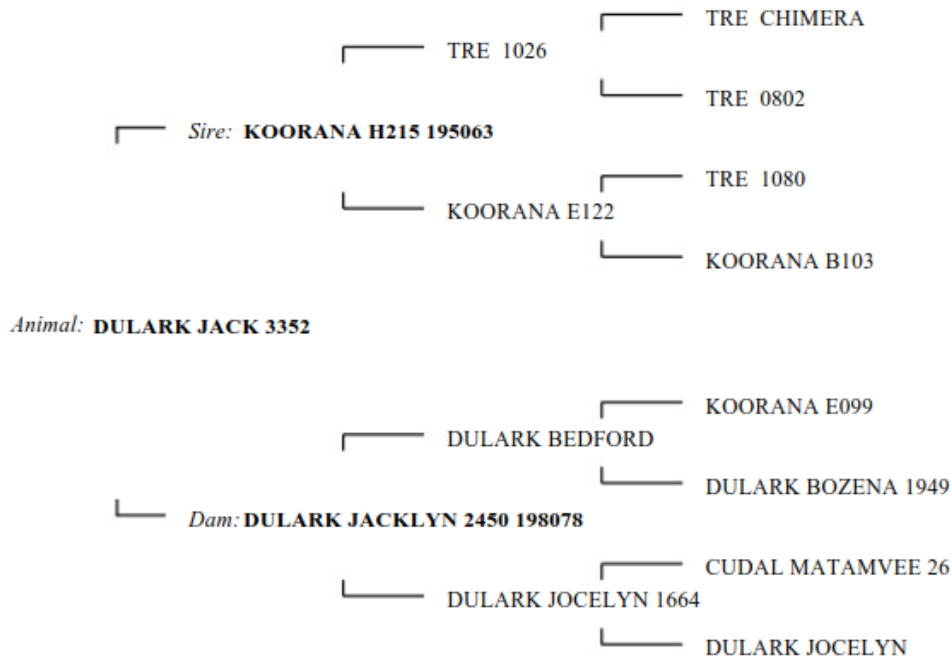
*Figure 3 Lot 29 Dulark Sushimi 3286*

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE SALE OF STUD STOCK BY AUCTION**

1. All bids at auction or offers to purchase are made on and are subject to these terms and conditions of sale (these terms) and bidders agree to abide by and acknowledge that they will be bound by these terms.

2. (a) The Vendor reserves the right to bid by agent or in person and may withdraw any lot or lots without declaring the reserve, and subject to Clause 9 the higher bidder will be the Purchaser but the Selling Agent without giving any reason whatsoever may refuse to accept the bidding of any person.

(b) The Selling Agent or auctioneer may settle any disputed bid or put up the stock again at the last undisputed bid and may settle any dispute over minimum bids.

(c) The auctioneer may refuse to accept any bid which the auctioneer believes is not in the best interest of the Vendor and may do so without giving any reason.

(d) A bidder will be deemed to be a principal unless prior to bidding the bidder has given to the auctioneer a written authority to bid for another person.

3. The stock will be in all respects at the risk and expenses of the Purchaser immediately on the fall of the hammer or in the case of a private treaty, immediately upon acceptance by the Vendor of the Purchaser's offer to purchase the stock.

4. (a) On conclusion of the sale and before delivery the Purchaser must pay for all stock purchased immediately in cash. The Selling Agent may require any bidder before or during a sale, to deposit with the Selling Agent, an amount on account of the purchase price.
